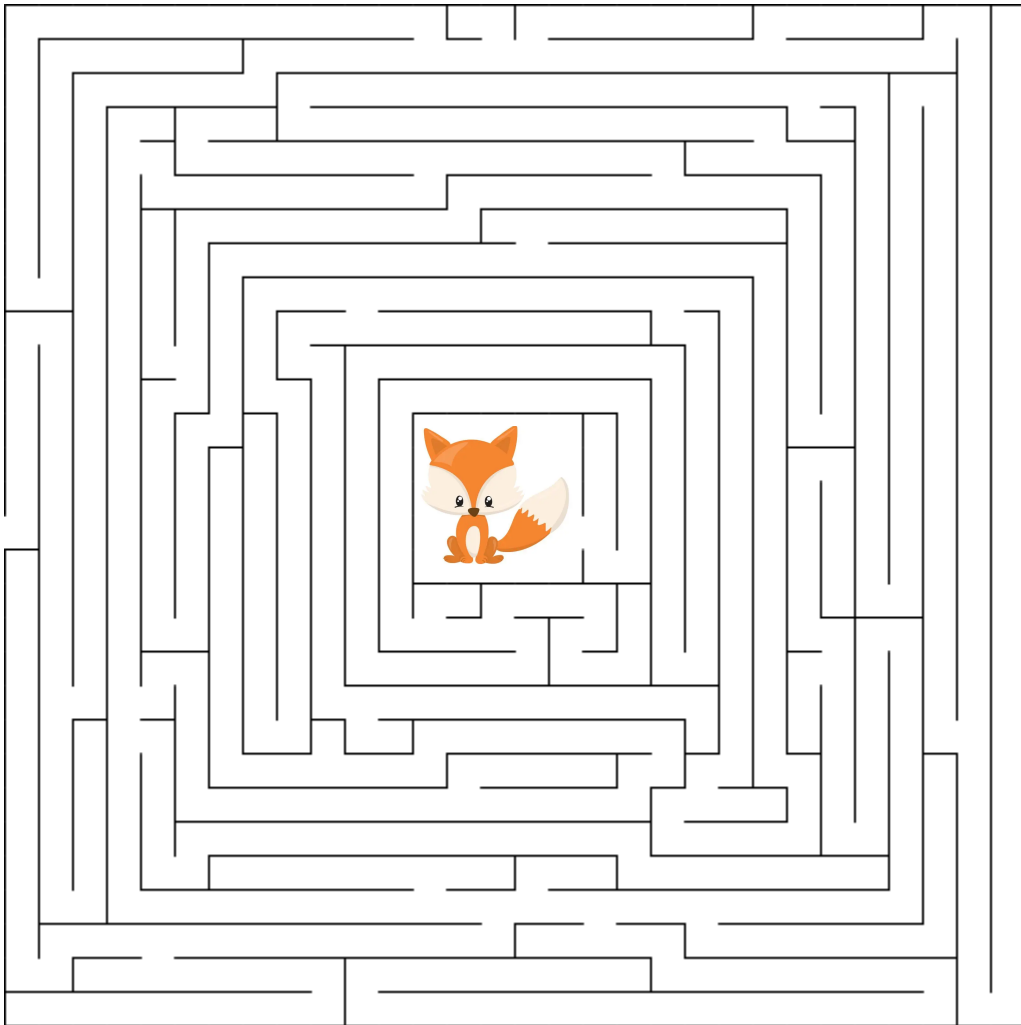

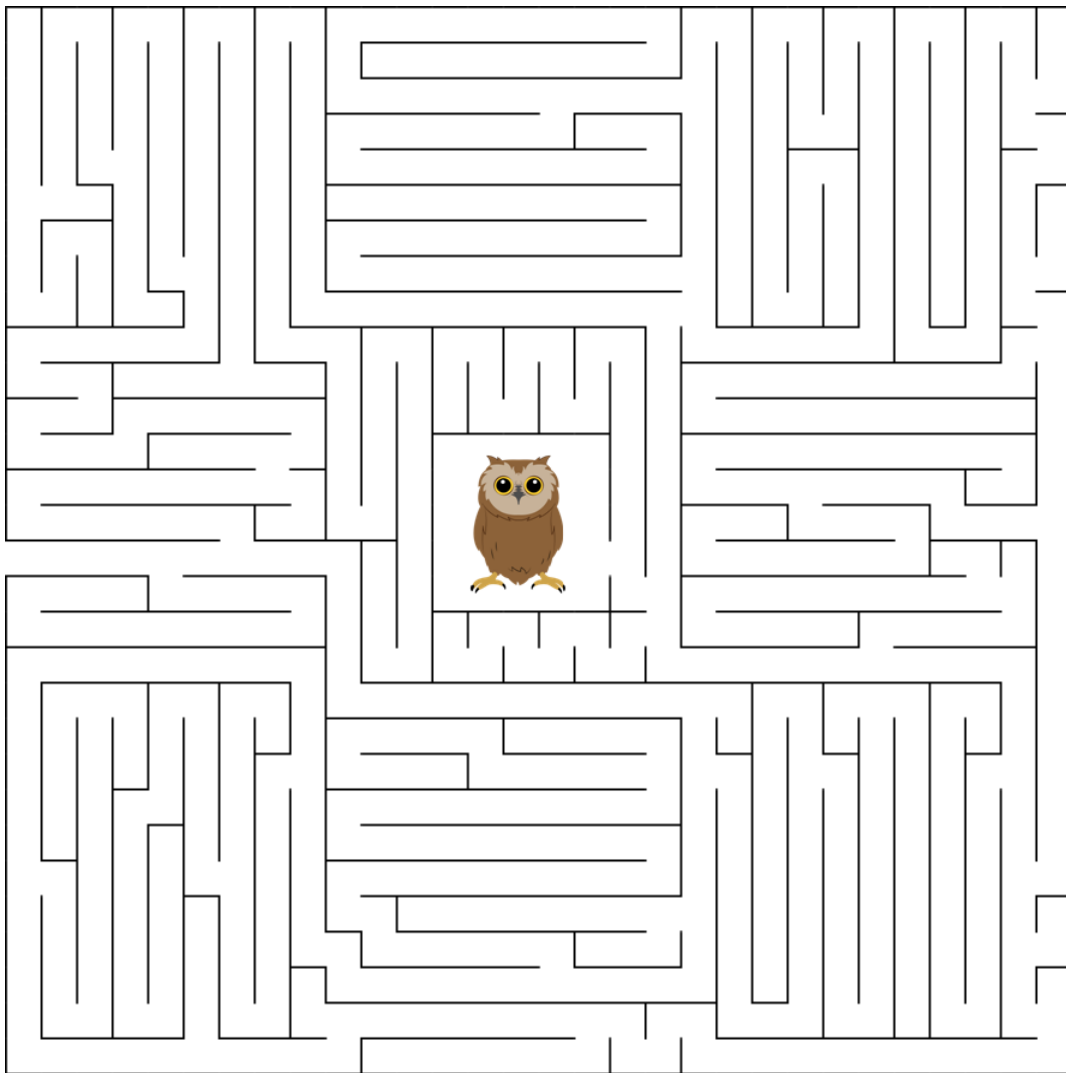

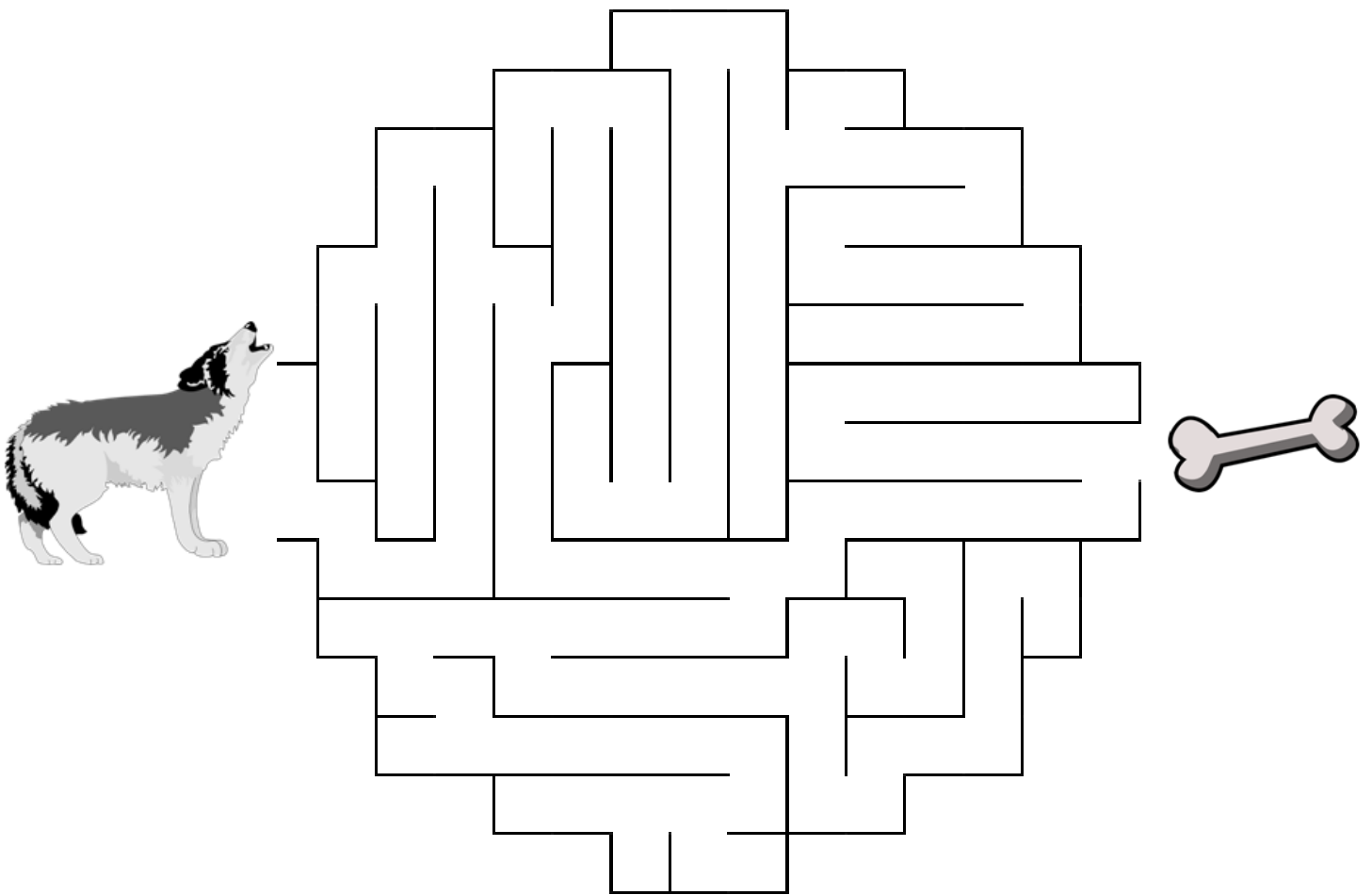

Help the Baby Coyote Find the Bone!

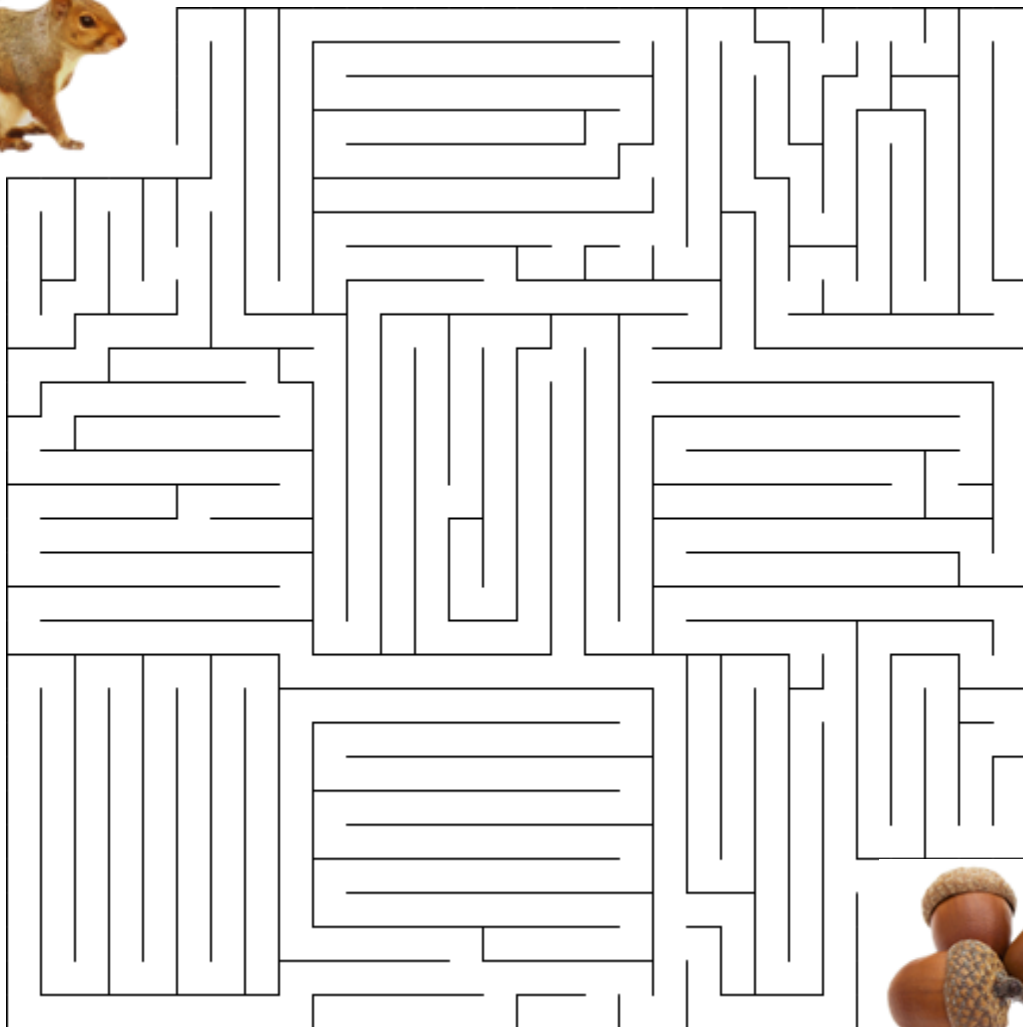
